## WELCOME TO THE SMWS BURNS TASTING

### UNDERSTATED OPULENCE

#### LIGHT & DELICATE

#### CASK NO. 39.198

An air of understated elegance, a subtle tropical floral scent with a very soft richness like a Hawaiian lei garland presented to us as a symbol of affection. On the palate, like a vintage pipe pouch made of leather in a rustic Kodiak brown oil finish, holding well-used pipes and a variety of tobacco next to all the other utensils. With a drop of water, a lovely burst of sweetness - a frangipani tree in full bloom and to taste now like a hummus dip served with pitas. After 27 years in an ex-bourbon hogshead, this whisky was transferred into a 2nd fill toasted oak hogshead for the remainder of its maturation. This toasted cask was previously used to mature Society cask 35.181.

### MOLECULAR GASTRONOMY

#### SPICY & SWEET

#### CASK NO. 35.387

We entered into a molecular gastronomy experience; the welcome drink was a test tube combining orange liqueur, pink peppercorn, smoked mince pie, birch sap, spiced mead and blackcurrant. Both the nose and the palate were full of sweet fruit and savoury spice. Water offered new discoveries, with wheatgrass pancakes enveloping cherrywood-smoked apricots and apple on the nose, calvados-spiked cola cubes and chewing tobacco on the palate, with a coulis of wild berries and ice cream to finish. After 27 years in an ex-bourbon hogshead, we transferred this to a first fill PX hogshead for the remainder of its maturation.

### TOFFEE AND COFFEE

#### JUICY, OAK & VANILLA

#### CASK NO. 88.32

Massaging leather conditioner into an old jacket, we caught the scent of a fresh batch of pastel de nata emerging from the bakery. Added to the nose we found rhubarb, lemon cream and black coffee. The palate was full of toffee and coffee, chocolate-coated raisins and currants. Water gave dark fruits, cedar and that new car scent, with the palate now oozing butterscotch and dates, tea leaves and candied pineapple. After 12 years in an ex-bourbon hogshead, we transferred this to a first fill, heavily toasted, medium charred hogshead for the remainder of its maturation.

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## WARM-REEKING' RICH!

### DEEP, RICH & DRIED FRUITS

#### CASK NO. 115.31

The neat nose suggested a nicely funky and slightly old-school sherry profile, with lots of drying earthy notes, tobaccos, pickled walnuts, balsamic and game meats. There was also a hint of animalistic aged pinot noir. Water brought an acetic edge, along with unlit cigars in a humidor, sharp red and dark pickled fruits, aniseed, camphor and tomato vines. The neat palate was well in sync with the nose, showing lots of aged balsamic, walnut wine, pickled tarragon, beef stock, camphor and black pepper. Water maintained this sense of funkiness, while adding another leathery aspect and some medicinal impressions of tar extracts and herbal cough syrup. This was matured in a bourbon hogshead for six years before being transferred to a first fill Spanish oak oloroso hogshead.

## SMOKIN'!

### LIGHTLY PEATED

#### CASK NO. 163.1

Descriptors for the aroma came fast and furious – gravadlax sauce, beech-smoked trout, black peppercorn-infused rye whisky and homemade sweet ploughman's pickle. The taste was like smoked brisket pastrami prepared in a brine of pink curing salt, sugar and spices, alongside mild goat's cheese on Jamaican gingerbread – intrigued? You should be! And what a change after the addition of water. Initially we stayed in the Caribbean with a warm Jamaican-style coffee and walnut cake followed by the sweet scent of cherry wood-smoked marshmallows. On the palate, we now found a mixture between a smoked battenberg cake and tiramisu with smoked cocoa powder.

## ROAST AND TOAST BY THE COAST

### PEATED

#### CASK NO. 53.485

After 10 years in ex-bourbon wood, this was transferred into a first fill American oak oloroso hogshead. The nose combined muirburn, burnt straw and pipe racks (smoke, ash, old wood) with black tea, dark chocolate and sticky honey glaze on roast pork. The smoke intensified on the palate, swirling around with roasting coffee, toasted pistachios and pumpkin seeds, golden syrup on burnt toast and a tingling finish of chilli, cardamom and smoked paprika. The reduced nose found old ship's timbers and hints of plastic on beach bonfires. The palate now had roasted chestnuts, burnt coconut and apple sauce on five-spice belly pork.
