### **BAR ROOM BUZZ**

#### **SWEET, FRUITY & MELLOW**

**CASK NO. 38.43** 

An errant overture of cherries, blackberries and red wine-poached pears became intricately woven into a wicked symphony of chocolate caramel, toasted walnuts and raspberry jam on scorched toast. Meanwhile, the charred raisins of a sumptuous fruitcake misbehaved with salted liquorice, plums, and cinnamon swirls. All of these antics were underpinned by fine oaky tannins that elegantly supported notes of tobacco and ginger wrapped in mint leaves. With a touch of water, an enchanting sonata of violets, rose petals and elderflower cider unfolded. Lush fruits then performed with glacé cherries, tropical confections and melon, complemented by a crescendo of sticky toffee pudding and treacle sponge cake. At 29 years of age, we combined selected casks from the same distillery. We then returned the single malt into a variety of different casks to develop further. This is one of

# RYTHMS OF THE SOUL

#### **DEEP, RICH & DRIED FRUITS**

**CASK NO. 1.292** 

This was full of goodness, with plums stewed in mulled wine, dark treacle, mixed fruit tarts and cherry walnut trail mix. The taste was simply sublime: chocolate orange, glazed fruits and fine marzipan with a layer of champagne-soaked strawberries coated in a rich dark chocolate. With a drop of water, the sound of a flamenco clapping rhythm appeared next to the typical Spanish guitar. On the palate this was sweet, like the most joyful flamenco style, the bulería, which is often performed at the end of a flamenco party. After five years in a bourbon barrel, we transferred this whisky into a first fill barrique from a privately owned small bodega, now in its ninth generation, that focuses exclusively on the Pedro Ximénez grape.

## **HARBOURSIDE HOOPLA**

#### **OILY & COASTAL**

**CASK NO. 93.207** 

The nose was a colourful collage of sea salt, dried kelp and pecorino romano; wasabi, rosemary and Assam tea; chamois leather, teak oil, pipe tobacco and toasted marshmallows – endlessly entertaining. The palate transported us to Campbeltown harbour, watching hessian sacks of grain being unloaded from an old paddle steamer, while we chewed tobacco, dried apple rings, fresh crab or smoked salmon, according to our preferences. Adding water brought a canvas-rigged sailing ship into the harbour; mariners in waxed jackets gave us peaches and orange blossom honey. The palate now had salted roast almonds and tannic notes of oak, hazelnut shells and old tea pots.

# MASCULINE CHARMS OF A ROUGH, HAIRY HIGHLANDER

#### **PEATED**

#### **CASK NO. 93.215**

The initial nose served up smoked haddock fishcakes cooked over charcoal on the deck of a manky puffer. The palate evoked barbecues – smoky heat, crispy smoked bacon or grilled gammon with pineapple – and was stout and robust, but with a rough, hairy highlander's masculine charm. For some of us the reduced nose recalled the dying embers of a beach bonfire at sunset and moonrise, while others were struggling with tractor repairs in a farmyard shed. The reduced palate delivered smoked ham and cheese toasties (with burnt edges), grilled prawns, salted caramel ice cream, apple crumble, lemon bonbons with a sprinkling of coal dust and a mouth-twisting, lip-smackingly dry finish.

## HONEYSUCKLE PETRICHOR

#### PEATED

#### **DISTILLERY 53 RARE RELEASE 2023**

Honeysuckle came glazed with a cocktail of rose water, bacon jam and barbecue sauce, plus a side dish of crab meat plucked from a vat of clarified butter. Need we say anything else? To the palate, this dram gifted smoked prune juice and cherry fondant served on driftwood. We also found crushed figs, apricot and brambles singed by a travelling firestarter intent on promoting the skills of cold smoking with peat. Introducing water elevated a smoked apple pie encased in a soft leather satchel, along with potted crab and rye bread. The palate offered a buffet of liquorice, smoked ginger and biltong, served on a bed of ash-dusted pebbles.

### PEAT IN PARTS PER THOUSAND

#### **HEAVILY PEATED**

#### CASK NO. 29.292

This one displayed all the usual refinements this distillery is famed for: peat smoke tinged with dried exotic fruits and encroaching waves of iodine, antiseptic, kippers and peppered mackerel for starters. Then, going deeper, we found it gathered complexity with suggestions of smoked olive oil, tarred rope, creel nets and wet beach kelp. Gorgeous! Water brought out big notes of boiler and puffer smoke, eucalyptus oil, more iodine, more antiseptic and more peat. The neat palate opened like taking a big swally of cask-strength German rauchbier, plus some chunks of barbecue-charred pineapple, pure tar extracts and briny olive pickling juices. Some water gave us preserved lemons, herbal ointments, soy sauce, bonfire embers and cornichons dashed on wet beach rocks – like a hyper-real version of this famous Islay distillery. This was matured in an oloroso butt for 20 years before being transferred to a refill PX butt.
